## Final Assessment Task

## Negotiating the price of items at the market

For this final task, you will video-record yourself asking for and negotiating the price of five market items with a classmate, friend, or a family or community member. You will be simulating a real-world marketplace exchange. We will practice this task together in class, but you will record yourself doing a final version (a task repetition) <u>outside</u> of class. This is the video you will submit as your final assessment for this unit.

To guide you, you can use the design of Task 4 that we did in class as a guide:

- 1. First, find five things that you will try to buy (these can be any items that you want).
- 2. Find your video partner, and explain to them that they will simulate being a 'vendor.'
- 3. Record yourself asking your partner for the price of all five things.

Try to negotiate at least one item.

See what your partner says!

4. At the end of the video, show and share all of the items that you will purchase, repeating each item's price, and say the total that you will be spending. (All in Spanish)

You must upload your video to your final learning E-Portfolio.

target-like during the video.
