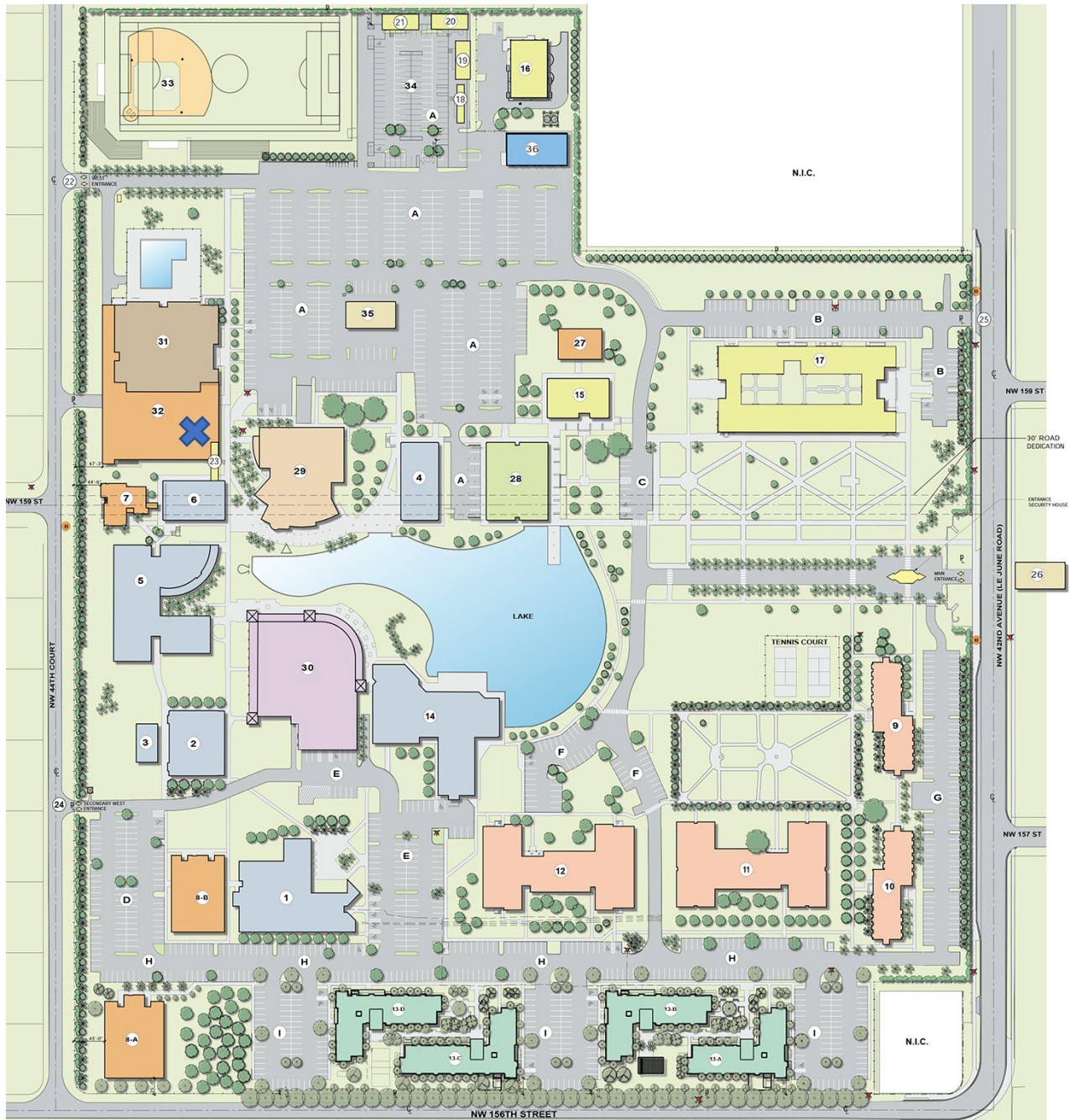


Final assessment task

For your final assessment task, you will be submitting a video of yourself ‘simulating’ a real phone conversation with an Uber driver.

You have ordered Uber Eats and the driver is trying to get to your location on campus, but is lost. Your location is indicated by the X below on the campus map. The driver has entered campus through the main entrance on NW 42nd Avenue. In the video, you are to give the directions to the driver on the phone (do not read what you say!). If you want to record the video with another person, you are welcome to, but only you will be graded. Record yourself giving the directions and upload your video (1-3 minutes) to your learning e-portfolio.



Assessment rubric for when you give the Uber driver directions on the phone (Unit 6 target task):

Criterion	Check off if completed
1. Student turned in video of themselves simulating a phone conversation with the Uber driver, in which they give the driver oral directions on how to get to their location.	<input type="checkbox"/>
