

Assessment Rubric: Video on study abroad in Spanish

Unit 6, Final Assessment Task 1

For your first final assessment task, you are to make a two-minute video of yourself talking **in Spanish** about a Spanish-speaking country that you want to see. In your video, you must include:

- (1) details on where the country is located
- (2) at least three interesting facts about the country, and
- (3) at least one way that you could study abroad in this country (e.g., a program at your university, a scholarship, etc.).

You must upload your video in Spanish to your learning e-portfolio.
